



**“A View of [Hawai’i] and its high Mountain [Mauna Kea]” March 30, 1820 by Samuel Ruggles**

### **ABOARD THE AMERICAN BRIG the *Thaddeus***

Sailing in the *Thaddeus*, 14 missionaries (seven mission couples) and four Hawaiian men left Boston, funded by the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions. They arrived in Hawai’i after 164 days.

The above drawing is from the Hawaiian Mission Houses Historic Site and Archives by Samuel Ruggles on March 30, 1820 “A View of [Hawai’i] and its high Mountain [Mauna Kea]”

He drew this while on the *Thaddeus* on the first sighting of land in Hawaii after their 164 day journey from New England. But he drew it from the perspective where he included themselves on the *Thaddeus* (the boat in the foreground).

This is the first (known, existing) drawing done by an ABCFM missionary, showing the landscape of Hawaii and an important record of the land at this moment in time! Drawing is important!

"Articles necessary as an outfit to the Sandwich Islands; it being deemed a sufficient supply for three years."

[Prepared by the Mission in 1834.]
