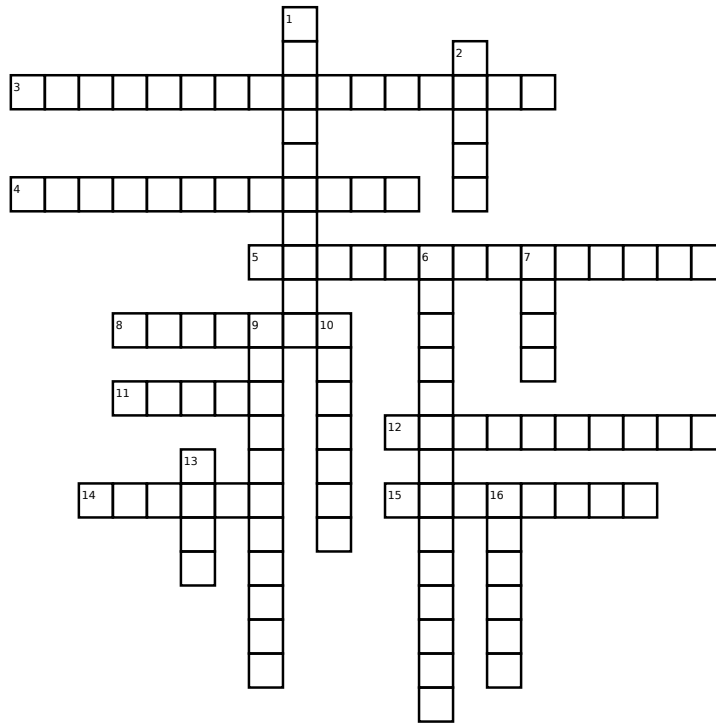


Hawaiian Mission Houses Crossword
